art – are (Example: Thou art quite loud.)  
betwixt – between  
caddish – wicked  
costermonger – seller of fruit and vegetables  
dost – do (Example: Thou dost read well.)  
-est – suffix attached to verbs (Example: When thou runnest, thou shalt not stumble)  
-eth – suffix attached to verbs (Example: He maketh my supper.)  
fishmonger – seller of fish  
hast – have when using thou (Example: Thou hast visited me.)  
hath – have when talking of someone else (Example: He hath visited us.)  
ironmonger – seller of goods made of metal  
shalt – future tense of shall (Example: Thou shalt not wander in the woods.)  
thee – you (Example: I will praise thee.)  
thou – you (Example: Thou art my friend.)  
warmonger – one who encourages war  
whence – where (Example: Dost thou know from whence he came?)  
wilt – will (Example: Wilt he go there?)
